- Glass Bottles and Jars (NO LIDS)
- Steel and Aluminium Cans
- Empty Aerosol Cans (NO LIDS)
- Newspapers
- Magazines
- Junk Mail
- Office Paper
- Envelopes Without a Window
- Phone Books
- Egg Cartons
- Cardboard
- Rigid Plastic Containers (NO LIDS) from kitchen, bathroom and laundry. Look for the recycling symbol.



**NO: X**

- Plastic Bags
- Bubble Wrap
- Polystyrene Foam
- Ceramics, Pyrex glass or Ovenware
- Cups, plates, wine or drinking glasses
- Mirrors
- Light bulbs
- Garden organic waste
- Food Waste
- Lawn Clippings
- Pot plant buckets/containers
- Nappies
- Food scraps
- Batteries
- Syringes/Needles

**What else can be recycled in Bogan Shire?**

- Mobile phones



Drop your phone in to the Post Office.

- Printer cartridges

Planet Ark collects these for recycling. Nyngan Post Office is a drop off point.

Bogan Shire Council also has a collection box for toners.



The recycling material collected from Nyngan households is manually sorted in Gilgandra by Carlinda Enterprises. If non-recyclables like those listed in red are placed in the blue bin, it contaminates the recyclables. **Our contamination rate** has increased dramatically and is not only inconvenient for the recycling centre but also costs Council, thus ratepayers, additional fees to have the recycling processed.
